Dr. A. P. Black Award (Click here for the application)

In honor of Dr. A. P. Black, the Operator's Association selects an Operator in Water, an Operator in Wastewater, and a Systems Operator, including stormwater and reclaimed water systems operators, whose outstanding personal performance is deserving of special recognition by the Board of Directors, as set forth below:

- Recognized individual service to the Association,
- Work done for fellow operators/systems operators,
- Outstanding (or exceptional under trying conditions) system operation, and
- Personal achievement.

Each regional director may submit a name for each category – Water, Wastewater, or Systems Operator. The selection committee shall consist of the Officers of the Board of Directors.

Emory Dawkins Award (Click here for the application)

This award, established in 1990, is named for Emory Dawkins, who worked many years as the editor of the *OVERFLOW* and the *FLORIDA WATER RESOURCES JOURNAL* - the official publication of the FW&PCOA, FSAWWA, and FWEA.

The submittal for this award consists of all the newsletters written during the twelve months of the previous fiscal year, to the Awards Committee Chair. The criteria used to determine the best submittal will include:

- The number of issues during the year.
- Total editorial content, which is the total pages per year less ads and blank space, if the blank space is a significant portion of a page.
- Information content, which is information about what has happened in the region or outside the region. Discounted are notices of upcoming events, lists of officers, location maps, jokes, registration forms, job openings and logos.
- Attractiveness, which includes layout aesthetics, reproduction quality, paper quality, type quality, and use of artwork (especially original artwork). This criterion could be divided into a number of sub-criteria, each with relatively few points, which is why when grouped together the attractiveness criterion shows more points than the other criteria.

It must be noted that any use of copyrighted material without permission will result in disqualification.

Raymond Bordner Award (Senior Systems Operators) (Click here for the application)

This award, established in 1990 and named in 2017 in honor of FW&PCOA Systems Operator Committee Chairman Raymond Bordner, honors Systems Operators, in both water distribution and wastewater collection, who have more than ten years of experience and whose outstanding personal performance is deserving of special recognition by the Board of Directors, as set forth below:

- Recognized individual service to the Association,
- Work done for fellow operations/systems operators,
- Outstanding (or exceptional under trying conditions) system operations, and



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Personal achievement.

Each regional director may submit one name for a Water Distribution System Operator and one for a Wastewater Collection System Operator. The selection committee shall consist of the Officers of the Board of Directors.

Nathan Pope Award (Stormwater) (Click here for the application)

The Nathan Pope Award is conferred on a person who has displayed dedication to the Stormwater programs in the State of Florida through the FW&PCOA. The FW&PCOA Stormwater Committee Chair, with assistance from the Association President and past award recipients, receives nominations and determines the award recipient. Criteria for this award are as follows:

- Must be a current member of the FW&PCOA.
- Candidate must possess a current certificate in Stormwater operations.
- Instructed in the Stormwater programs consisting of the C, B, and A levels.

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Prepared, coordinated and made public presentations to the communities on the protection of the water and its environment through Stormwater protection.

Theodore Kamien Award (Backflow and Cross Connection Control) (Click here for the application)

The Theodore Kamien Award is conferred on a person who has displayed dedication to the Backflow and Cross-Connection Control programs in the State of Florida through the FW&PCOA. The FW&PCOA Backflow Committee receives the nominations and determines the award recipient. Criteria for this award are as follows:

- Must be a current member of the FW&PCOA.
- Candidate must possess a current certificate in Backflow Testing and/or Repair and Maintenance.
- Instructed in the Cross-Connection Control programs consisting of Backflow Tester, Backflow Repair and Maintenance, or Cross-Connection Control Management.

or

Prepared, coordinated and made public presentations to the communities on the protection of the water and its environment by conducting Cross-Connection Control programs and the necessary involvement needed by the consumers.

Robert E. Heilman Award (Industrial Pretreatment) (Click here for the application)

The Robert E. Heilman Award is conferred on a person who is involved in an Industrial Pretreatment Program, who has demonstrated excellence of performance, and who has shown dedication, commitment and an innovative approach to the Industrial Pretreatment Program in Florida above and beyond the requirements of the regulations. The FW&PCOA Industrial Pretreatment Committee receives the nominations and determines the award recipient.



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Joseph V. Towry Award (Reclaimed Water) (Click here for the application)

The Joseph V. Towry Award is conferred upon an individual who has demonstrated a high level of competence and dedication to the Reclaimed Water Industry in the State of Florida through the FW&PCOA. The selection committee will be comprised of the members of the FW&PCOA Reclaimed Water Committee. Criteria for this award are as follows:

- Must be actively involved in the management of and/or field inspection and operations aspect of the Reclaimed Water Industry in Florida.
- Member of good standing in the FW&PCOA preferred.
- Industry-related certification preferred.
- Must have a minimum five- (5) year's experience in the field of Reclaimed Water.
- Must have instructed in the FW&PCOA Reclaimed Water Certification program

or

Prepared, coordinated and made public presentations to community and professional organizations on the production or permitted uses of Reclaimed Water

or

Demonstrated a high level of competence in the daily operation of a Reclaimed Water System.

Utility Maintenance Award (Click here for the application)

The FW&PCOA presents the Utility Maintenance Award to a person who has displayed dedication in the field of utility maintenance. Criteria for this award are as follows:

- Must be a current member of the FW&PCOA with at least one year of membership.
- Candidate must possess a current certificate in Utility Maintenance or write a short narrative on the candidate's knowledge of the plant and its equipment.
- Must have instructed a Utility Maintenance course during a scheduled short school.

or

Has demonstrated proper recordkeeping skills for maintenance activities and has repaired treatment plant equipment.

Outstanding Web Site Award (Click here for the application)

The FW&PCOA recognizes the growing importance of the Internet, and its use as a tool in providing service to our customers. The Outstanding Web Site Award was established by the FW&PCOA Board of Directors on November 3, 2001. This award shall be presented annually to a water, wastewater, stormwater, or reclaimed water utility or municipality within the state that is judged to provide the most outstanding internet web site to their customers. Criteria for this award are as follows (Note: The following requirements MUST be met for a site to be considered for the award. Failure to meet even one will be grounds for automatic disqualification):

- The site must provide content that is related to the water, wastewater, stormwater, or reclaimed water fields, and the entity being considered.
- The Utility/Municipality must provide services within Florida.



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• Sites run by a parent company outside of the state will not qualify, unless significant content and support are provided for their subdivision that is within Florida.

Nomination may be made by one of the following three methods:

- Utility companies or municipalities wishing to be considered can submit their request on the nomination form, with a cover letter from an authorized official requesting their site be considered. All applications would be received by the FW&PCOA Webmaster no later than June 1st of the year the site is to be considered.
- Any member in good standing of the FW&PCOA may submit a nomination of a site requesting the Association consider a utility company or municipality which that member feels qualifies. All nominations would be received by the FW&PCOA Webmaster no later than June 1st of the year the site is to be considered.
- If the number of applications and nominations is less than ten, the Website Committee shall survey member utility sites and, until a minimum of ten sites are on the nomination list, select those sites they feel exemplify the qualities, mission, and values the Association wishes to promote.

The Website Committee will compile all applicants, verify they meet the minimum requirements for the award (see below), and submit a "judging package" with an evaluation sheet for each qualifying site to the Executive Board for judging.

Safety Awards (Click here for the application)

The Florida Water & Pollution Control Operators Association advocates that in order for a utility to be successful, it must incorporate a sound safety and health program into its standard operating procedures. A good safety program must embody proper attitudes toward injury and illness prevention by employers, supervisors, and employees. It requires cooperation on all safety and health matters, not only between the employer and employee, but also between employees and their co-workers.

In recognition of the importance of safety, the FW&PCOA presents awards each year to facilities that employ our members and have an outstanding safety performance record during the previous calendar year. Plaques are presented at the annual Awards Luncheon held in conjunction with the Fall State Short School.

The award criteria take into consideration the size of each facility and its number of employees so that smaller facilities can compete fairly with larger ones. The following criteria are also included:

- Facilities do not have to be totally accident free to be eligible.
- The documentation requested in the application form is not mandatory, but it does aid the committee in its decisions and therefore can be an asset for the applicant.
